Please read the following competition requirements and rules:

1. Any vocalist who resided in Loudoun County attending junior or senior high school, or being home schooled at those levels is not a previous first place winner, is eligible to participate. Each contestant must complete and sign the registration form below.
2. Contestant shall perform only one vocal composition and is allowed three (3) minutes to present it. In order to keep within the 3 minute time limit, contestants may eliminate part of his or her composition. The part cut out shall be marked on the score for the information of the judges.
 - a. Contestants must memorize the composition performed.
 - b. Contestant shall provide (3) copies of his or her composition as for the judges.
 - c. A piano will be provided for the performance. Pre-recorded accompaniment is not permitted.
3. Judges will be provided at the competition that has a musical theatre background therefore providing quality adjudication.
4. Contestants give permission for the use of their names and / or photographs in publicity, press releases and publications, covering all levels of this competition.
5. Competition time is limited so it will be based on a first come first service in the registration process. You must register no later than February, 28th, 2010.
6. The competition will be held on Sunday, March 7th from 2:00-5:00pm. The time could be extended if there are an abundance of applicants. However, there will be a limit to how many students we are able to accept. Practice rooms will open one hour early.
7. Students in the Jr. Division will go during the first half while the senior division will go towards the later half. If you need to perform at a different time due to a conflict, please note that on your application.
